演讲嘉宾

Lv Ping is a feminist activist focusing on strategic advocacy to combat gender-based discrimination and violence. She started her work on women's rights in the late 1990s. In 2009, she founded Feminist Voices, China's largest new media platform on women's issues. Since 2012, she has been devoted to supporting the activism of young feminists across China. She now resides in Albany, New York, where she continues to follow the feminist movement in China closely.

吕频,媒体背景的女权活动家,自 1990 年代末起开始参与中国民间妇女组织的活动,2009 年创立中文互联网最有影响的女权传播平台"女权之声",2012 年后开始致力于支持青年女权行动者的网络和倡导活动。2015 年3 月起暂居美国纽约州,仍然关注和跟进中国国内的女权活动,并参与在美中国女权社群的培育。

WANG Zheng is Professor of Women's Studies and History and Research Scientist at the Institute for Research on Women and Gender at University of Michigan. She is the author of *Finding Women in the State:* A Socialist Feminist Revolution in the People's Republic of China, 1949-1964; Women in the Chinese Enlightenment: Oral and Textual Histories and the coeditor of From the Soil: The Foundations of Chinese Society; Translating Feminisms in China; and Some of Us: Chinese Women Growing Up in the Mao Era. An academic activist who has been promoting feminist curricular transformation in higher education in China, Wang Zheng is the founder and co-director of the UM-Fudan Joint Institute for Gender Studies that is located at Fudan University, Shanghai.

王政,密西根大学历史系和妇女研究系教授,兼任妇女与性别研究所研究员。王政教授的中英文著述颇丰,包括《中国社会主义女权革命》,《中国启蒙时期的女性:口述与文本的历史》、《毛泽东时期成长的中国妇女》,《翻译女性主义在中国》,《女性的崛起:当代美国女权运动》、《越界:跨文化女权实践》、《妇女与社会性别选译》等。王政教授也是个女权活动家,致力于在中国高校女权课程设置的改革,并首任位于复旦大学的"密西根大学-复旦大学性别研究所"共同所长。

LV Xiaoquan is Executive director of Beijing Qianqian Law Firm (the former Legal Research and Service Center for Women of Peking University Law School). As a public interest lawyer, he has devoted himself to legal aid, research as well as advocacy for women's legal rights, and actively promoted laws on women's rights and gender equality. Throughout his practice, he has dealt with numerous cases involving the protection of women's or girls' legal rights, including their rights and interest in marriages, economic and labor rights, personal rights and interests, property rights and interests, rural women's land rights and interests. LV won the "Public Interest Advocate" Award in 2013 in a nationwide competition organized jointly by Nandu All Media Cluster and the Southern Metropolis Daily.

吕孝权,北京市千千律师事务所/北京众泽妇女法律咨询服务中心(原北京大学法学院妇女法律研究与服务中心)执行主任、公益律师,专职从事妇女权益法律援助、研究与倡导工作,积极参与涉及妇女权益和性别平等问题的法律推进工作。执业以来,承办过一批涉及妇女/女童权益保护的典型案件,涵盖妇女婚姻家庭权益、经济和劳动权益、人身权益、财产权益、农村妇女土地权益等,其中一些具有全国性影响(如辽宁营口嫖宿幼女案、河南桐柏 20 名幼女被老师性侵案、宁夏灵武 12 名学龄前幼女被老师性侵案等)。在南都全媒体集群与南方都市报联合举办的责任中国 2013 公益盛典评选活动中,获评"公益人物奖"。
